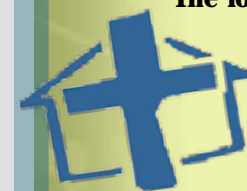

2010 Summer Missions

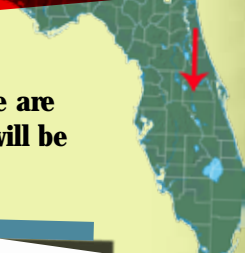
*Serve God,

This summer in ELEVATE Student Ministries we will be going out to four places around North America that desperately need to know God either for the first time or in a new way. We as students will be learning how to better serve a lost and dying world through sacrificing our time, energy and money to be able to connect with people in Orlando, Alabama, North Carolina and Mexico and make a meaningful difference in their lives. The incredible thing about the God we serve is that when we bless others, He blesses us as well, and we will come back from these trips changed.



The local mission trip is **June 27-July 2**, and is for **current 6th-8th grade students**. They will be working with Impact Florida ministries here in Orlando to help those less fortunate and in need in our area. We will spend all week with other churches from around the country helping those in our own area with home construction and repair as well as building relationships with those we are helping. On our day off we'll be going to Blizzard Beach (included in trip price). We will be staying at a church in Orlando during the week and going out from there.

S.I.F.A.T., AL

We'll have a new trip this year from **July 18-23**, which is for **current 6-8th grade students**; it's called S.I.F.A.T. or Servants in Faith and Technology. We'll be participating in the learn and serve program at the facility in Lineville, Alabama. This program is designed to learn about diverse cultures, different living conditions and some of the technologies that S.I.F.A.T. uses around the world. "As students are exposed to the 'real world' (not the one seen on MTV), we empower them to "serve" somewhere, whether in their local community or internationally."



RE-CREATION, NC

For many the difference between being homeless or staying in their home may be as simple as the roof you replace, the rotting floor you repair, the windows you seal or the walls you paint. You can help restore the pride of a neighborhood or a community by sharing your faith through hammers, paint and hard work. From **July 18-24**, all of you **current 9th- 12th grade students** will be on our out-of-state mission trip. We will conclude the week with whitewater rafting (included in trip price).



The out-of-country trip, **June 24-july 1**, is for **current 9th- 12th grade students**. You will be going to Ensenada, Mexico to work with the people of this area. You will be working with those less fortunate and will be building an entire house for a family this week. You will also be repairing homes for people who are literally living in shanties, working with children in orphanages, sharing their faith, feeding the homeless, and much more to impact this city for Christ. We will be going through the mission organization YWAM (Youth With A Mission) and their base in San Diego. Make sure you're getting your passport ready to go!

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO BE PART OF A SUMMER MISSION TRIP?

1. Pray and ask God to give you direction in whether or not you should go.
2. Read through this entire application. If you have questions, then call Andy 407-644-2906.
3. Attend one of the **MANDATORY** informational meetings with your parents:
 - Sunday, April 11th @ 12pm in MFLC 313
 - Sunday, April 18th @ 4pm in MFLC 313
 - Wednesday, April 21st @ 7:15 in MFLC 205

4. Fill out this application, including personal information sheet, and turn in your picture (stock brochure), name and address, and a **\$100 non-refundable deposit** (that goes towards your total cost) by **April 25th**. SPACES FOR EACH TRIP ARE LIMITED. PRIORITY IS BASED ON FIRST FORMS TURNED IN (will try to add space if possible).

5. If you plan to participate in the stock program, complete the **typed list of 25+ names and addresses** for your stock letters and email it in to Andy (andy@fumcwp.org).

Each participant in any of the mission trips will have to:

- Attend several training sessions prior to the trip.
- Take on specific job responsibilities as part of the team.
- Be at every fundraiser and meeting in a timely manner.
- Spread the word about the mission trip and help raise money for it through the "Stock Program" and other fundraisers.
- Work in cooperation with the other team members to make the mission a success.
- Pray on a regular basis for our trip and the people we will encounter.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Note: These are each student's costs but the remainder of what the trip itself costs will be raised through fundraisers such as the Stock Program below, art festival parking lot, rummage sale, and others.

DETAILS ABOUT THE STOCK PROGRAM



The total cost, if all three mission trips are full, will be approximately \$42,000. The participants and the church will be paying approximately \$27,000. The remaining \$16,000 has to be raised by the students through fund-raising projects or students paying the full amount.

The main method for raising this money is through the sale of stock. Each participant will write 25+ people a letter and enclose

a "Stock Brochure." The brochure will include a color picture and information about the participant as well as details about the mission project they are taking part in. In the brochure the recipient is asked to consider purchasing one or more "shares of stock" for \$10 a share. For more information, read enclosed page.

You must turn in with your application a **typed** list in the format below of 25+ people you think will support you on your mission trip.

Remember: You need to write down people who you think will sponsor you. Not just someone to fill a gap! If two students put the same person down, then the person who turned their info in first will get to send a brochure to that person, and the later student will have to find another person to meet the 25 requirement.
